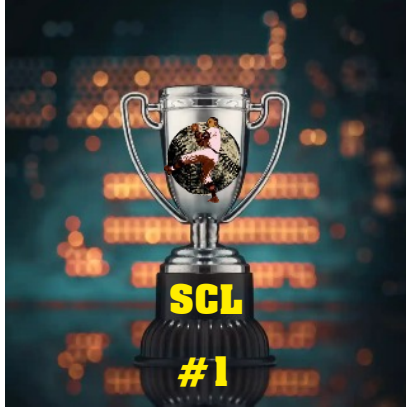

The Tide led 5-0 going into the 5<sup>th</sup> inning after scoring 3 runs in the 1<sup>st</sup> on Ty Cobb and Chris Spearman rbi singles and a bases loaded walk to Clarence Lindsey. Oscar Charleston tripled in a run and scored on Ty Cobb's sac fly in the 4<sup>th</sup>. The Stogies tied it up in their half of the 5<sup>th</sup>, with the big hit being a bases loaded triple by Dobie Moore. The Tide put this one away scoring 6 runs over the final 3 inning. Frankie Frisch had 4 hits and is hitting .643 in the tournament. Ty Cobb's 3 hits raised his average to a robust .786.
