# 1915 Shamokin Stogies vs 1923 Georgia Pines

Jeff Tesreau vs Hubert Lockhart

The Stogies scored 3 in the 2<sup>nd</sup>, a lead-off single followed by a walk put runners on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>. Bill Rariden laid down a sac bunt, but Lockhart booted it to load the bases. Tesreau hit a 2-run single, and a Les Mann ground out scored the 3<sup>rd</sup> run. In the 7<sup>th</sup> Edgar Wesley got the Pines within 1 with a 2-run home run, his 3<sup>rd</sup> of the tournament. In the 8<sup>th</sup> Rogers Hornsby had an rbi double, Heavy Johnson had a sac fly, and Candy Jim Taylor had an rbi single to put the Pines up 5-3. With Oscar Levis on the hill for the Pines, the Stogies tied the game at 5 on a Les Mann sac fly and an rbi ground out. In the last of the 9<sup>th</sup>, with 2 outs and a runner on 2<sup>nd</sup> Archdeacon hit a walk off single to win it for the Pines.
