Tesreau hit a 2-run single, and a Les Mann ground out scored the 3rd run. In the 7th Edgar Wesley got the Pines within 1 with a 2-run home run, his 3rd of the tournament. In the 8th Rogers Hornsby had an rbi double, Heavy Johnson had a sac fly, and Candy Jim Taylor had an rbi single to put the Pines up 5-3. With Oscar Levis on the hill for the Pines, the Stogies tied the game at 5 on a Les Mann sac fly and an rbi ground out. In the last of the 9th, with 2 outs and a runner on 2nd Archdeacon hit a walk off single to win it for the Pines.
