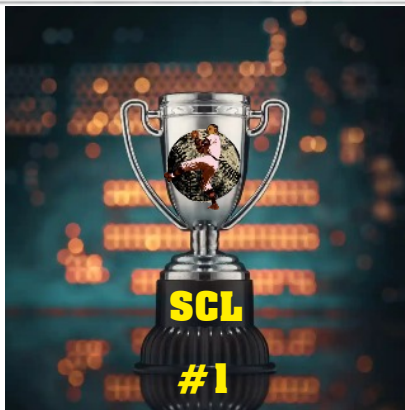

The Pines scored single runs in the 2nd and 3rd innings. A 2-out double by Pelayo Chacon and a 2-out single by Candy Jim Taylor drove in the runs. In the Warbirds 5th, 1-out singles by Burt Shotten, and Art Fletcher set up Miller Huggins' 2-out single, tying the score 2-2.

In the Pines 6th Edgar Wesley and Louis Santop opened the inning with singles. A sac bunt and a sac fly scored Wesley. Stuffy McInnis booted a 2-out ground ball, allowing Santop to score, giving the Pines a 4-2 lead.

In the Warbirds' 7th, Burt Shotten reached on a Candy Jim Taylor error at 3rd. One out later Ted Easterly doubled Shotten to 3rd. Miller Huggins singled in Shotten, and Stuffy Mcinnis singled in Easterly to tie the score 4-4.
